ONE -DAY ASSESSMENT AND SCREENING OF PROSPECT TRAINERS FOR THE
REGIONAL TRAINING ON CRITICAL CONTENTS IN SCIENCE, FILIPINO, ENGLISH AND
MATHEMATICS

1. A One-day Assessment and Screening of Prospect Trainers for the Regional Training on **Critical Contents** in Science, Filipino, English and Mathematics shall be held on **April 12, 2018** at **RELC II, Teacher Development Center, Butuan City** from **8:00 AM to 4:00 PM only**.
2. The objective of the activity is to ensure that the following standards, established by the Central Office in determining the trainers on critical contents, are met:
 - a. be experts/specialists in the learning area;
 - b. have taught the learning area for at least 5 years, preferably in the indicated grade level;
 - c. have been involved in previous trainings as trainers/facilitators/writers;
 - d. possess excellent communication and facilitation skills;
 - e. be physically fit;
 - f. not more than 55 years old; and
 - g. must obtain 85% in the mastery test of their learning area.
3. Based on the recommendations of the Division Education Program Supervisors in the above mentioned learning areas, the Regional Office has initially determined the following prospect trainers and alternates per learning area, subject to the confirmation of the Schools Division Superintendents:

4. The above mentioned prospect trainers and alternates are required to bring the following on **April 12, 2018**:
 - a. laptop
 - b. extension wire
 - c. portable wifi
 - d. photocopy of Diploma/TOR
 - e. Certificate as trainer/facilitator/session guide writer in any level
 - f. Certification of learning area assignment and grade level assignment, signed by the School Head/Principal
 - g. QAME Ratings or latest RPMS Rating
 - h. Medical Certificate by DepEd Medical Officer within 6 months
5. The above mentioned prospect trainers and alternates are required to be around at 8 AM since the online mastery test shall start at exactly 9:00 o'clock in the morning of **April 12, 2018**.
6. All Division Education Program Supervisors in Science, Mathematics, English and Filipino are encouraged to take the mastery test.

7. After the assessment and screening, the final and official Regional Trainers shall be determined by the Regional Office based on the submitted required documents and the results of the mastery test. In Science, only ten (10) Grade 4 trainers and ten (10) grade 8 trainers. In Mathematics, only nine (9) Grade 4 trainers and nine (9) Grade 8 trainers. Filipino has ten (10) Grade 7 trainers; and English has fifteen (15) Grade 7 trainers, respectively.
8. Prospect trainers and alternates are required to submit upon arrival their TRAVEL AUTHORITY, proof of the confirmation and approval of Schools Division Superintendents.
9. Traveling expenses, accommodation and per diem of the prospect trainers and alternates shall be charged against **School MOOE funds** subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
10. Immediate and wide dissemination of this **Memorandum** to all concerned is highly desired.
