1. The Association of DepEd Directors (ADD) Inc. shall convene the **National Assembly of Education Leaders** with the theme Hold IT in Trust: LEADING in the Time of Industry 4.0 on September 25-27, 2018 at the Manila Marriott Hotel Grand Ballroom, Pasay City.
2. The assembly aims to provide education leader-participants the opportunity to strengthen their capabilities in achieving the goals of the K to 12 Basic Education Curriculum Program.
3. All Central Office management staff, namely: bureau, service directors and chiefs of bureaus and services, and field personnel, particularly the regional directors, schools division superintendents, assistant regional directors and assistant schools division superintendents, division chiefs of the regional and division offices, regional, division and district supervisors, school heads and Career Executive Service Written Examination (CESWE) passers are authorized to attend. The members of the Secretariat and working committees who shall provide support in the conduct of the assembly are also authorized to attend. Attendance shall be on **official business**.
4. A registration fee of Six Thousand Pesos (P6,000.00) shall be charged to each participant on a live-out basis. The fee shall cover the following to cover the cost of meals (lunch and snacks), rental of venue, honoraria of resource speakers, kits, including supplies and materials, and other expenses. Participants shall make their own arrangements for their travel expenses, board and lodging and other incidental expenses. On the other hand, DepEd participants shall charge the registration fee, board and lodging and other incidental expenses to the funds of their respective offices, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
