1. In conformance with the conduct of the 2<sup>nd</sup> National Competition on Storybook Writing, DepEd Caraga through the Learning Resource Management and Development Center (LRMDC) will hold a series of contests and activities to come up with the regional entries for the national level competition.
2. The Regional Level Competition shall compose of three (3) major competitions which are:
  - a. Judging of the Storybook Manuscripts on September
  - b. Contest on Storybook Designing and Illustration
  - c. Judging of Storybook with Design and Illustration
3. The judging of all first three winners in the division level contest of storybook manuscripts shall be done at the regional office on September 6-7, 2018, while the judging of storybook with design and illustration shall be on October 18-19, 2018 at the regional office.
4. Division LR Supervisors and all Illustrators and Layout Designers who are interested to join the contest on Storybook Designing and Illustration shall convene at the LRMDC-DepEd Caraga, Butuan City on September 20, 2018 at 1:00 o'clock P.M. for the orientation and distribution of manuscripts to be illustrated and designed. They shall bring with them the duly accomplished. Official Entry Form. See attached Enclosure No. 1.
5. Submission of storybooks with layout, design, and illustrations, both print and soft copy shall be on or before October 16, 2018 at 5:00 o'clock P.M at DepEd Regional Office, Butuan City. All Division LR Supervisors shall take charge of gathering and submitting the designed and illustrated storybook.
6. Any entry found to have been copied and or plagiarized shall be automatically disqualified. In cases where such was only proven after the awarding, the winning entry and its prize shall be revoked and the award list shall be adjusted.
7. Travelling and other incidental expenses of the LR Supervisors or their authorized representative shall be charged to local funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
8. Immediate dissemination and compliance of this memorandum to all concerned is highly desired.

1. The Department of Education (DepEd), through the Bureau of Learning Resources (BLR), announces the **2nd National Competition on Storybook Writing**.
2. The competition aims to:
  - a. select and award the best storybook originally developed by teachers for the K to 3 grade levels;
  - b. recognize the skills and competencies of teachers in writing and illustrating stories for children; and
  - c. collect storybooks for uploading on the Learning Resources Portal, and for printing and delivery nationwide.
3. The competition is open to all public elementary school teachers with permanent status, including Alternative Learning System mobile teachers and Senior High School teachers.
4. Any entry found to have been copied or plagiarized shall be automatically disqualified. In cases where such was only proven after the awarding, the winning entry and all its prizes and recognition shall be revoked and the award list shall be adjusted.
5. The decision of the board of judges is final and irrevocable.
