2. The SDOs-SGOD shall prepare the Deployment Report by school district. Priority shall be given to school/district with acute teacher shortage. The teacher needs for ALS per district may be determined using the parameters of 1:75 as ideal class size.
3. SDO-SGOD Chief shall carefully examine the deployment report before submitting to RO-PPRD, Regional Office for consolidation. SDOs shall commence with the recruitment, evaluation and selection process based on the guidelines set forth in DepEd Order Nos. 7 and 22, s. 2015. It is expected that processes shall be completed on or before November 9, 2018 in preparation for the required training of newly hired teachers *afterwhich*, they shall likewise be assigned by December 14, in time for the start of ALS learning interventions.
4. Submission of Deployment Report through the PPRD Office **shall be on or before September 14, 2018**.

SUBJECT : **Advance Information on the Allocation of New Teaching Positions for Alternative Learning System (ALS) for CY 2018**

DATE : August 1, 2018

This is to inform all concerned field offices that **two thousand (2,000)** new teaching positions for Alternative Learning System (ALS) have been allocated for CY 2018. The creation of these items was requested from the Department of Budget and Management (DBM) by the DepEd Central Office (CO).

Prior to DBM's approval and issuance of Notice of Organization, Staffing and Compensation Action (NOSCA), the Regional Office (RO) and Schools Division Office (SDO) shall complete the following process:

- The Office of the Assistant Secretary for Public Affairs Service and Alternative Learning System shall provide the electronic copies of the allocation **by division** to the RO;
- Upon receipt, the RO shall immediately forward the said allocation to the concerned SDOs;
- The SDO-SGOD shall prepare a deployment report **by school district**. Priority shall be given to school district with acute teacher shortage. Teacher needs per district may be determined using the parameters of 1:75 as ideal class-size.
- The deployment report shall be submitted to the RO-PPRD for consolidation on or before September 14, 2018;
- RO-PPRD shall ensure that the deployment report by school district shall tally with the allocation of each division. A consolidated Excel file of the deployment report shall be submitted to the office of Assistant Secretary G.H. S. Ambat through email address: [asec.pas.als@deped.gov.ph](mailto:asec.pas.als@deped.gov.ph) copy furnish [ps.ppd@deped.gov.ph](mailto:ps.ppd@deped.gov.ph) on or before October 12, 2018; and

- Lastly, all SDOs shall commence with the recruitment, evaluation, and selection process based on the guidelines set forth in DepEd Order Nos. 7 and 22, s. 2015.

It is expected that the process shall be completed on or before November 9, 2018 in preparation for the required training of newly hired teachers. All newly hired teachers shall likewise be assigned by December 14, 2018 in time for the start of ALS learning interventions.
