PRE-EMPTIVE ADVISORY FOR THE LPA TO DEVELOP INTO TROPICAL DEPRESSION TO ENTER CARAGA REGION

TO: **ALL SCHOOLS DIVISION SUPERINTENDENTS**
This Region

1. Be informed that a low pressure area (LPA) is expected to enter the Philippine Area of Responsibility (PAR), tomorrow, January 19, 2019 (Saturday) and possibly become a tropical depression in the next 24 hours. If the LPA develops into a tropical depression inside PAR, it would become the Philippines' first tropical cyclone for 2019 and would be given the local name *Amang*.
2. For this matter, all Division Offices and its schools are hereby advised to conduct preparedness measures to lessen the impact of the said weather disturbance. Particularly:
 - all computers and other electrical equipment are unplugged; and,
 - textbooks, school records, furniture and other important materials are moved to safe areas,
 - with the help of the communities, secure the roof beams with wires and heavy duty ropes,
 - board-up jalousies and windows with plywood or other secure material,
 - prune trees especially those adjacent to buildings and along electrical posts; and,
 - secure all on-going construction projects including supplies and materials.
3. For schools that may be designated as Evacuation Centers, School Heads should immediately contact their respective Division Offices via text message and identify the School Coordinator and contact details.
4. All DRRM Coordinators must stay alert and monitor the effects of the weather disturbance while SDSs/ASDs are requested to report their whereabouts and conditions to their Division DRRM Coordinators every 8:00am and 5:00pm. All SDSs/ASDs are also advised to coordinate with their Local DRRMO on class suspensions, resumptions and other information concerning the schools.
5. Should there be damages incurred in schools/offices related to this, a consolidated division report must be submitted to the Central Office thru DRRMS copy furnish the Regional Office using the prescribed Rapid Assessment of Damages Report (RADaR) Template. The School DRRM Coordinators may also send an immediate text message using the RADaR Format to DRRMO thru mobile phone nos. 0928-871-8053/0915-205-3244.

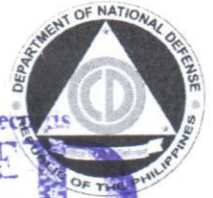

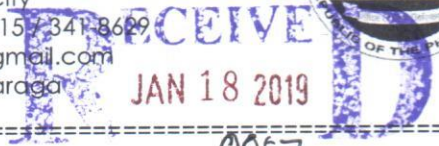
