We are pleased to inform your good office that **Steps Early Intervention** in partnership with Philippine Charity Sweepstakes Office recently launched a program for Free Therapy to children and adult with impairments.

STEPS has envisioned to provide interventions to individuals who may need the service regardless of financial capacities of parents.
