The Bureau of Learning Delivery (BLD) thru the Teaching and Learning Division (TLD) will spearhead the National Roll-out of Multigrade Program in Philippine Education Monitoring (MPPE) and Evaluation System.

The national roll-out of MPPE M & E system intends to create an increased awareness among DepEd central, regional, division, district, and school levels on the MPPE M & E framework, system, and tools. Specifically, it will:

1. develop common understanding on the M & E framework's principles and concepts for the multigrade program among the DepEd personnel;
2. make consensus on the goals, outcomes, outputs, inputs, indicators, as well as responsibilities of the MPPE actors from various DepEd levels of governance for MPPE M & E system;
3. provide a clear schematic orientation on how to use the developed MPPE M & E system and tools;
4. discuss how to effectively provide technical assistance to multigrade schools based on M & E findings; and
5. serve as a springboard for the formulation of potential guidelines or DepEd policy on MPPE M & E system to be officially adopted by DepEd.

The training participants are the Chiefs of CLMD, CID, SGOD, Multigrade Coordinators, Education Program Supervisors or District Supervisors. Participants of the recently concluded 2018 National Training of Supervisors and Multigrade Principals/School heads on the Management and Supervision of Multigrade Schools are not allowed to participate in this training. Number of participants for each region is found in *Enclosure 1.A* (Luzon), *Enclosure 1.B* (Visayas), & *Enclosure 1.C* (Mindanao). Priority in the selection of participants is given to divisions with considerable number of multigrade schools.

It is requested that the Compensatory Time-off (CTO) be granted to the participants in lieu of the training day/s that will fall on either holiday or weekend in accordance with the CSC and DBM Joint Circular No. 2, s. 2004. Participants are expected to be at the venue on the first day of the training at 10:00 in the morning for the registration. The training will officially begin at 1:30 in the afternoon. Check-out time will be on the last day of the training at noon time.

Travel expenses of the participants shall be charged against 2018 Support Funds for Multigrade Schools to be downloaded to regions, which will in turn download the budget allocation to selected divisions. In the event that the downloaded funds are not enough to cover the travel expenses of participants, each participant shall charge the additional budget to local funds, subject to usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations. The participants are encouraged to avail the shortest/direct route and most economical fare prevailing in the area.
