

Caraga State University- College of Education (CEd) plans to expand the program offerings next academic year 2020-2021. Currently, the college endeavors to open new program the Bachelor of Physical Education (BPE) and new specializations: Bachelor of Secondary Education Major in English and Bachelor of Secondary Education Major in Filipino.

This plan came into view when the results of the CSU-Information Drive Survey Feedback came out whereby 32% of the Senior High School students prefer to take BPE in college; 28% of them choose BSEd-English; and 26% of them want to take BSEd-Filipino. The results would be a good rationale for offering new specialization. However, the College believes that it is best to examine the needs of teachers in the field more particularly in our partner agency –the Department of Education.

In view of this, the undersigned would like to request from your office an assistance which would reinforce our claim that there is a need in the DepEd secondary schools of English, Filipino, Physical Education teachers. A certification or any document would be much preferred and would be much appreciated by the college.
