**GUIDELINES ON THE CONDUCT OF THE REGIONAL BRIGADA ESKWELA
2020 AWARDS**

1. Pursuant to DepEd Memorandum OU-LAPP No. O-008 s. 2021 dated December 29, 2020; all Schools Division Offices (SDOs) through the Social Mobilization Networking Section (SocMob) under the SGOD are enjoined to conduct the Search for 2020 Brigada Eskwela Best Implementing Schools following DepEd Memorandum No. 53, s. 2020 entitled Joint Implementing Guidelines on the 2020 Brigada Eskwela and Oplan Balik Eskwela Relative to the COVID -19 situation.

2. In line with this, the Division Brigada Eskwela coordinators together with the division and regional partnership focal persons during their virtual meeting last February 5, 2021 agreed to come up with the following agreements:

- i. Same categories of schools as the previous years will be evaluated as contenders of the Brigada Eskwela Awards namely:
 - a. Elementary (small, medium, large, mega and most sustained school)
 - b. Secondary (small, medium, large, mega and most sustained school)
- ii. The following criteria cited in DM OU-LAPP Np. 0-008 s. 2021 shall be used however some rubrics are agreed upon :

- a. Brigada Eskwela Partnerships Engagement Activities – 40% (This pertains to the kind/impact of partnership engagement activities which may be measured in terms of the number of learners/teachers/non- teaching personnel benefited by the activity.)
- b. Resources Generated relative to the COVID-19 Situation – 30% (This shall be based on the prevailing market value of the items donated. SEF shall not be included in the computation. A matrix patterned after the previous BE contest shall serve as basis of the allocation of points per category (Please refer to attached matrix for details)
- c. Bayanihan effort to support the BE-LCP implementation – 30% (This shall reflect the equivalent of the volunteer man hours generated from the partnership activities. This shall include all forms of partnership engagement (virtual or face to face) provided the specific conditions of the





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respective LGUs during the conduct of the activity and the health protocol set by the AITF were strictly considered with MOVs.

- d. The 3 criteria of judging sums up to a total of 100%.
3. SDOs are directed to refer to the BE-LCP dated May 2020 for the activities and partnership engagement recommended during the pandemic.
4. The SDOs shall submit their entries through the google drive by division, by folder, by category with a transmittal not later than March 15, 2021.
