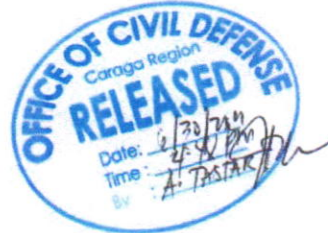

DRRM JINGLE CONTEST 2021

I. Mechanics

- 1.1 The DRRM Jingle Contest will **NOT** be conducted face to face due to COVID-19 and its variants in the region;
- 1.2 It is open to all public schools in the region (*Junior and Senior High Schools*);
- 1.3 There shall only be **ONE (1)** entry per school division. Thus, a total of 12 entries are expected to participate in the contest;
- 1.4 The jingle entry must be an **ORIGINAL** piece. Music plagiarism is **STRICTLY PROHIBITED** since Caraga RDRRMC does not promote the use or close imitation of someone else's works/outputs. Further, the entry must not have been used in any jingle or song competitions;
- 1.5 The DRRM jingle must be lively and creatively sung in Filipino/Tagalog that will revolve around and will best relate to this year's NDRM theme. No use of foul, mean, offensive, and rude words;
- 1.6 The jingle must run from a minimum of three (3) minutes to a maximum of four (4) minutes in **A CAPELLA** by only seven (7) members due to the pandemic. A minute of extension shall incur an automatic deduction of one (1) point from the total garnered score. The use of any instrumental accompaniment is discouraged;
- 1.7 The jingle shall be performed and video recorded **WITHIN THE SCHOOL PREMISES** and **NOT** within any public places such as plazas/parks, beaches, churches, markets, malls, among others to ensure the safety of students, teachers, and those who are involved in the recording of the jingle;
- 1.8 The following shall be submitted to OCD Caraga through e-mail at **caragandrm.jinglecontest2021@gmail.com** on or before **JULY 21, 2021**:
 - Jingle entry;
 - Manuscript of the Jingle/Lyrics;
 - List of students and coach/es; and
 - Scanned official endorsement by the Division Office (*duly signed*)
- 1.9 All jingle entries will become property of the Caraga RDRRMC and will be used for advocacy and awareness activities;
