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SECOND YEAR OF IMPLEMENTATION OF THE LEARNING DELIVERY
MODALITIES (LDM) PROGRAM AND OTHER CONCERNS

DepEd Order No. 29, s. 2021 titled "School Calendar and Activities for School Year 2021-2022" released on August 5, 2021, stated that "the Basic Education Learning Continuity Plan (BE-LCP) as contained in DO No. 12, s. 2020 titled "Adoption of the Basic Education Learning Continuity Plan for School Year 2020-2021 in the Light of the COVID-19 Public Health Emergency" shall continue to provide guidance on the delivery of basic education for S.Y. 2021-2022." (p. 2, no. 12).

Please be informed that the LDM Program for Teachers and School Leaders, as part of the BE-LCP Courses, shall still take effect this school year. It shall be a non-compulsory course that may be participated by the following DepEd personnel:

- a. teachers with more than three (3) years of teaching experience and have not undergone the LDM courses last year,
- b. SDO-designated school LAC Leaders,
- c. newly promoted school heads, and d. newly promoted supervisors.

There will be a scheduled orientation in October for the RO and SDO LDM Program Management Team (PMT) where information about the LDM Courses that will be cascaded to those who would like to undergo them will be discussed. Please be advised to wait for another advisory on said orientation before starting the courses to avoid duplication of tasks.

Regarding the submission of last year's Forms 4/4P, RO and SDO Form Managers are requested to indicate the email addresses of the participants and their gender (male or female) in the Forms 4/4P for as part of the requirements for the awarding of the PD credit units.
