FOUNDATION OF VALUES EDUCATION

Units: 3

Units: 3

Units: 3

In doing so, the students are expected to recognize cultural elements that are distinctly Filipino and choose that are worth perpetuating.

PSHCO-SPIRITUAL DEVELOPMENT

Units: 3
