

We are optimistic that this activity will paved the way for the betterment of the organizations and to strengthen the campus journalism program in the region in this trying times.



Target Participants:

Platform: Online

Rationale:

RA 7079 also known as Campus Journalism Act of 1991, declared that the policy of the state to uphold and protect the freedom of the press even at the campus level and to promote the development and growth of campus journalism as a means of strengthening ethical values, encouraging critical and creative thinking, and developing moral character and personal discipline in the Filipino youth.

However, the different journalism activities are hampered due to the global adversities. The covid 19 pandemic has created a negative impact on the continuation of the advocacy of the schools in promoting campus journalism.

Due to this, the School Paper Advisers association in elementary and secondary of Caraga region in partnership with the Teacher Reinvented Master classes shall hold different sets of master classes on different schedules. This is intended for a long term input and presentation of knowledge so that participants develop competence in the field so they can practice journalism in the right manner and right purpose as training grounds of the budding journalists.

There are three (3) sets of Master classes intended for this webinar series. Each set will be charging 1,800.00 per participant to defray expenses on the webinar series which is set to start on May 13, 2022 to October 21, 2022.

Objectives:

- a. create awareness and deeper understanding of development communication and journalistic writing, concepts and principles;
- b. Acquire basic skills and develop competence in writing;
- c. gain knowledge and skills in campus paper management; and,
- d. exercise creativity to produce quality outputs.
