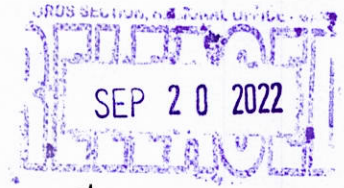



The Department of Education recognizes the importance of maintaining an accurate and comprehensive inventory of school buildings, classrooms, furniture, and other facilities for use in planning, budgeting, resource allocation, and decision making. Specifically, the said inventory will help strengthen the commitment to provide a safe and conducive learning environment to our learners, especially now that the Department is preparing for full implementation of in-person classes for SY 2022-2023.

Hence, schools are required to submit their data in the National Schools Building Inventory (NSBI) for SY 2021-2022 to meet this objective. However, some schools either did not submit their data or submitted incomplete data, resulting in a low turnout of data in the system.

In this regard, the NSBI **shall be reopened from 16 September 2022 to 30 September 2022**, in order to cater submissions from schools. The Division Planning Officers shall inform the concerned School Heads of the said reopening and advise them to update their submissions in the NSBI.
